DAY 1: FRIDAY WELCOME TO ULURU

Welcome to Uluru – the spiritual heart of Australia. You'll be met on arrival at Ayers Rock Airport and transferred to your hotel.

The remainder of the day is at leisure to relax poolside or participate in one of the complimentary resort activities.

Tonight's exclusive welcome dinner is much more than a dining experience; it's a moment in time you will remember forever. Tali Wiru, meaning 'beautiful dune' in local Anangu language, encapsulates the magic of fine dining under the Southern Desert sky. The stillness of the desert at night creates a unique ambience, while views of Uluru and the distant domes of Kata Tjuta provide a stunning backdrop.

Sip champagne and nibble on canapés while watching a spectacular sunset to the haunting sounds of a didgeridoo performance.

Every course of this exclusive four course dinner is infused with ancient native herbs and spices, constructed to respect, and put a spotlight on the quality and attributes of each ingredient, bringing them together in harmony. Dinner is accompanied by premium Australian wines while an indigenous storyteller shares the culture, history and spirituality of this beautiful land.

DAY 2: SATURDAY DESERT AWAKENINGS & SACRED SITES FLIGHT

Experience the tranquillity of the pre-dawn land under a canopy of stars and watch the amazing transformation of colours and life as the desert awakens. See Uluru up close and watch the distant domes of Kata Tjuta come in to view as you enjoy a traditional Aussie breakfast complete with homemade damper. Once the sun is up, enjoy a guided tour at the base of Uluru. First stop is Kuniya, where you'll take a short walk to the Mutitjulu waterhole. Here, you will appreciate its cathedral like proportions and understand why it is such a powerful and spiritual place for visitors and the Anangu people alike. See rock paintings and listen to stories from the creation period as told by the Anangu people. Next stop is the Cultural Centre, a vibrant and engaging place of learning where the local lore of the Anangu is explained in detail.

This afternoon, get ready for the ultimate Uluru adventure and experience the true majesty of Uluru and Kata Tjuta from the air. Fly by Uluru and across to the spectacular domes of Kata Tjuta for a view that will leave you speechless. So much of these sacred sites is off-limits from the ground, so the only way to truly appreciate the vast size and amazing landscape is from the air.

Prior to dinner, enjoy a glass of sparkling wine as you undertake a private guided tour of the Gallery of Central Australia, featuring around 80 works of Indigenous art. Dinner tonight is a relaxed dining experience in Ilkari Restaurant. Relive the highlights of a remarkable day at Uluru with your fellow travelling companions as you enjoy three delicious courses, enlivened by indigenous flavours.

DAY 3: SUNDAY KATA TJUTA & A NIGHT AT FIELD OF LIGHT

An early start this morning to experience the magnificence of a Kata Tjuta sunrise. On arrival at the viewing area, walk to the best vantage point to see the 36 domes that comprise this spiritual place, watching as the sun's morning glow brings the desert to life.

The tour then heads to the western side of Kata Tjuta where you'll enjoy an outback picnic breakfast. Approaching the entrance to Walpa Gorge, named for the wind that whistles between the massive domes that shape Kata Tjuta, your guide will share the significance of this men's sacred ceremonial site. Take a stroll between the mighty conglomerate rock walls and learn how the environment and geology have evolved over millions of years.

Next stop is the Uluru Cultural Centre for a private dot painting workshop. Learn about traditional art, symbols, and tools from a local Anangu artist (and assisting interpreter). Get inspired by the ancient ways of the desert and create your very own work of art to treasure. Throughout the workshop, the artist will share a part of their culture with you and help you to better understand Aboriginal paintings and culture. The tour will return to the resort around 1pm.

Late afternoon, you'll be transferred to a remote desert location with majestic views of Uluru. As the sun sets on the horizon, enjoy gourmet canapés and chilled sparkling wine, and soak up the ambience of your last evening in the Red Centre.

As darkness falls, watch in awe from the top of your private dune as the coloured lights of 50,000 glass spheres gently come to life, then join your fellow travellers for an exceptional three course menu infused with bush tucker flavours. As the night ignites with countless stars, settle back and listen to the resident star talker decode the southern night sky.

After dinner, immerse yourself in the stunning art installation, Field of Light, its pathways glistening softly with rhythms of coloured light, beckoning you to explore at your own pace.

Return to the hotel and reflect on a truly magical evening.

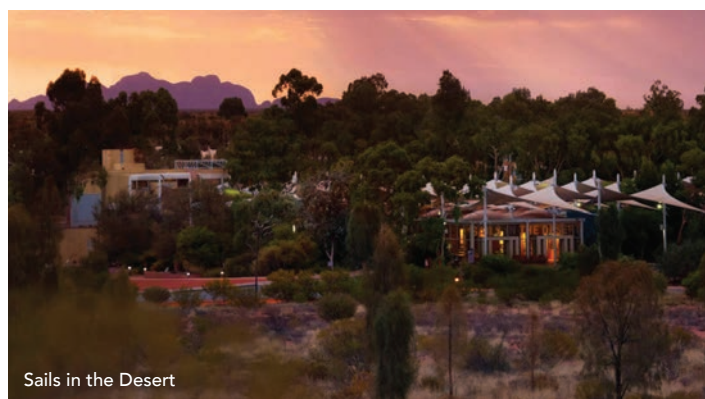

Your food journey begins with a welcome dinner at one of Hobart's best restaurants. Savour food straight from the paddock to table at the Fat Pig Farm's Friday Feast. Experience a Rockstar afternoon at Mona with a five course degustation dinner at Faro. Taste your way across Bruny Island, sampling the island's local produce. And sample some of Tasmania's best wine and cider. Staying in luxury accommodation, it's the ultimate way to experience Hobart's thriving culinary scene.

DAY 1: THURSDAY WELCOME TO HOBART

On arrival at Hobart Airport, your driver will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free for you to explore the city.

Tonight, meet your fellow travellers over a glass of sparkling wine in the Story Bar before the short walk to Aloft for our welcome dinner. Located on the top floor of the award-winning Brooke Street Pier, Aloft boasts one of the most stunning views of Hobart's Derwent River. Dolphins, seals, spectacular sunsets, and dramatic weather changes provide a backdrop for what is sure to be a tantalising journey for your tastebuds. The five course tasting menu focuses on local produce with a Pan-Asian twist of flavour, inspired by the changing seasons and the raw nature of Tasmania, accompanied by matched wines.

DAY 2: FRIDAY A FRIDAY FEAST AT FAT PIG FARM

This morning we head south of Hobart to the beautiful Huon Valley for what is sure to be a feast for the senses. Our first stop is Home Hill Wines, one of the most popular and well-loved destinations in the Huon Valley. What started as a relaxing hobby farm with six rows of vines has turned into an award-winning vineyard producing some of Australia's top Pinot Noir. Relax on the deck and taste a selection of wines while your host imparts their knowledge of the vineyard and wines.

Continue on to Fat Pig Farm, home to Gourmet Farmer and author of nine cookbooks, Matthew Evans. On their 70-acre farm, Matthew and his family nurture food from the soil to turn into great meals for the farmhouse table. Join in the Friday Feast and enjoy dishes straight from the gardens and paddock – all seasonal, all grown by hand and all cooked in the open kitchen. In between courses, tour the farm, including the 1.5 acre market garden. The meal is celebrated with specially matched beer, wine, cider and spirits from around Tasmania. Settle in for a long, lazy afternoon!

On the way back to Hobart, we'll stop at Willie Smith's Apple Shed and learn a little about Tassie spirits. Take a stroll through the distillery and be introduced to the process used to create the unique cider spirits and fine apple brandies. Get up close and personal with the copper alembic Charentais still – one of a kind in Australia – and taste Apple Spirit and Apple Brandy. Return to Hobart fully satiated and enjoy a relaxing evening.

DAY 3: SATURDAY SALAMANCA MARKET & A ROCKSTAR AFTERNOON AT MONA

After breakfast, the morning is free to explore the famous Salamanca Market at your own pace. Held every Saturday, it's one of Australia's most vibrant and loved outdoor markets. Here, you'll find a collection of more than 220 stallholders representing artisans, designers and producers. Tasmania's 'Own Market' is one of those special places where you can find Tasmanian handmade and home grown produce, talk to the makers and producers, and discover the heart of this creative and resilient island.

This afternoon, head to Mona for your Rockstar experience. Mona, the Museum of Old and New Art, is Australia's largest privately-owned gallery and museum. Showcasing the diverse collection of its owner, Tasmanian gambler and maths nerd David Walsh, Mona exhibits everything from ancient Egyptian funerary objects and modernist masterpieces to a word waterfall and a machine that mimics the human digestive system. Your Rockstar experience kicks off as you board the Mona ferry and settle into The Posh Pit – of course! Enjoy Moorilla wine, Moo Brew beer and canapés as you sail up the Derwent River to Mona.

On arrival, enjoy an absinthe-heavy cocktail from the Void Bar before heading into the museum to check out David Walsh's sprawling underground collection of art and antiquities. Then swan into the museum's Faro Bar and Restaurant for an excessive, five course feast imagined by Rockstar executive chef Vince Trim. Sip on fancy wines delivered from Mona's infamous wine bunker. You'll then have exclusive access to some neuron-tingling James Turrell artworks to further addle your synapses, before your coach transfer back to the hotel.

Step back in time with a walk through the ancient Mavista Rainforest and breathe in the cleanest air as you stroll under the towering canopy.

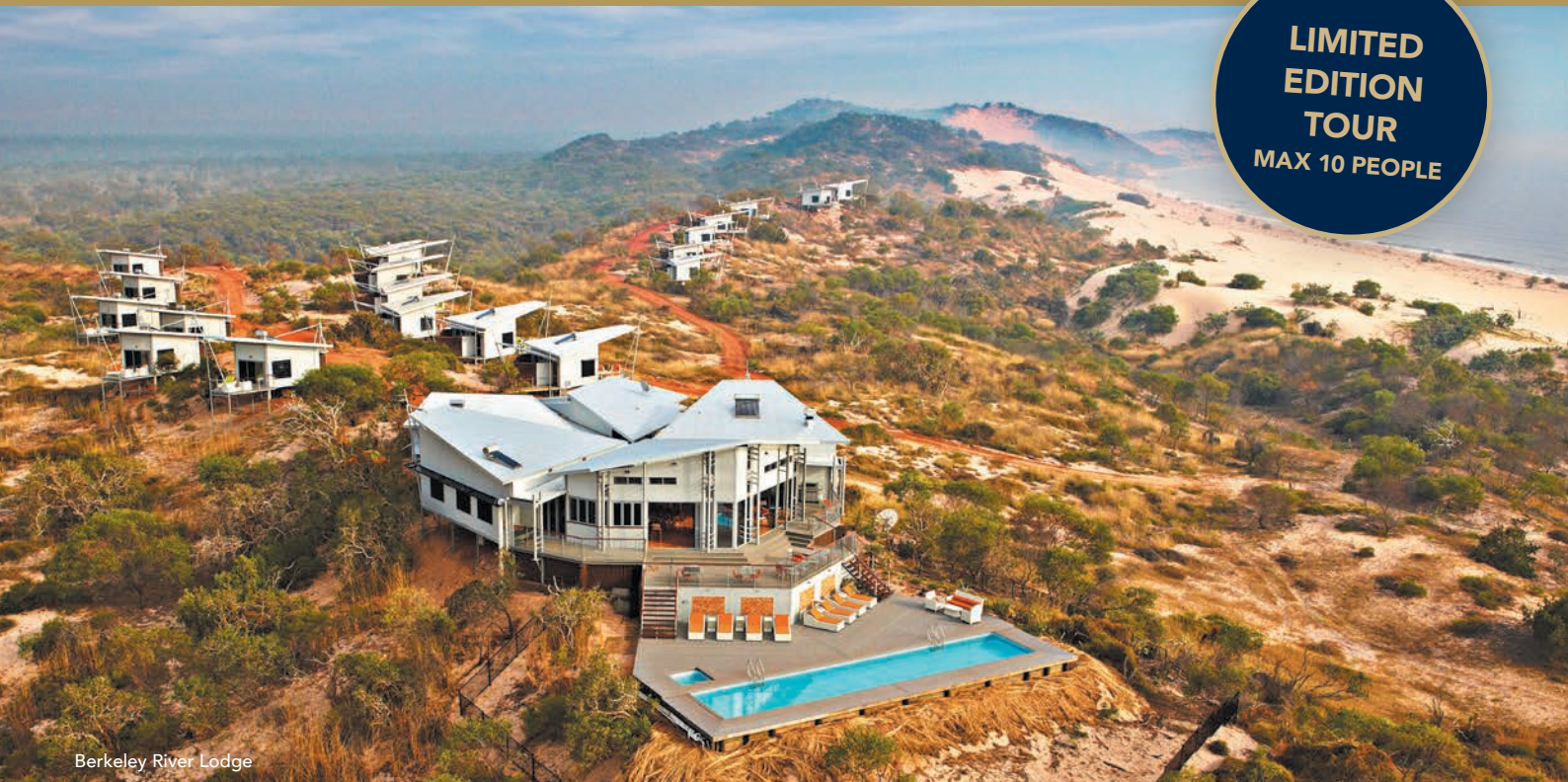

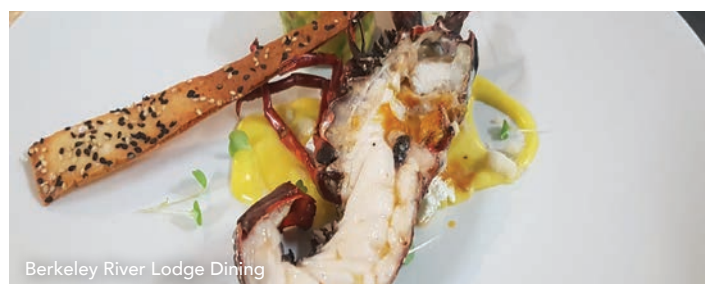

Enjoy a cold drink and gourmet cheese platter before returning to the Lodge, where a delectable five course dinner awaits.

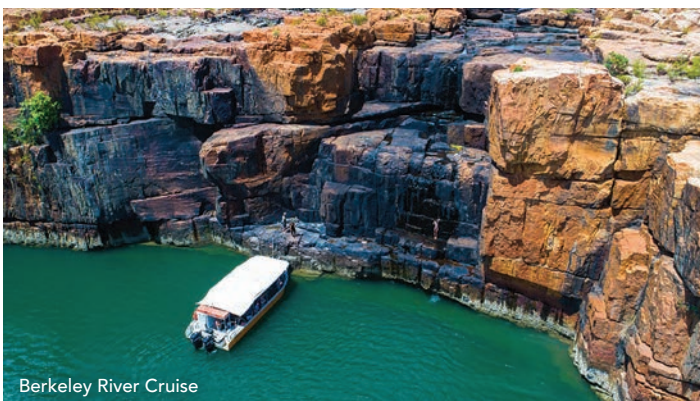

DAY 5: TUESDAY 4 OCTOBER KING GEORGE FALLS*

Delight in a morning of rest and relaxation. Laze by the pool or on your villa deck with a good book, or perhaps join an optional tour. Enjoy lunch at Dunes restaurant taking in the unprecedented views across the expanse of the Timor Sea and the impressive backdrop of the Berkeley River mouth, Reveley Island, and the spectacular Kimberley coastline.

This afternoon, be among the fortunate few to enter some of the greatest galleries of rock art in the world. Departing the Lodge by helicopter follow the coastline before heading inland to land and tour some of these spectacular galleries. Next is the majestic King George Falls where you will have the opportunity to capture some aerial shots. As the journey continues to the mouth of the Berkeley River and along the deep gorge, you may spot Jabiru, turtles, crocodile and even glimpse an elusive dugong. There is time to cool off from the Kimberley sun with a landing right next to a picturesque waterhole, where you can relax and enjoy a refreshing swim and a cold beverage. Finish the day watching a marvellous outback sunset with canapés and drinks before arriving back at the lodge. Enjoy your final five course dinner with your fellow adventurers before drifting off to sleep.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY 5 OCTOBER WELCOME TO EL QUESTRO & CHAMBERLAIN GORGE CRUISE

Upon arrival at Kununurra Airport, transfer by helicopter to El Questro Homestead. After settling into your room, enjoy a delicious lunch and wander the grounds before an afternoon Chamberlain Gorge Cruise. An El Questro ranger will guide you along this three kilometre fresh waterhole in the Homestead's private dinghy. Sit back and enjoy the diverse flora and fauna and resident Rock Wallabies, Johnston Crocodiles and the cheeky Archer Fish. Relax on the peaceful return journey at dusk when the colours of the Kimberley shine on the towering cliffs. Time to freshen up before dinner under the stars.

DAY 7: THURSDAY 6 OCTOBER EL QUESTRO GORGE WALK & SUNSET AT BUDDY'S POINT

After breakfast, head off on a guided El Questro Gorge walk. Hike along a narrow spring-fed creek that leads you through palm and fern clad escarpments to a small swimming hole in a lush rainforest setting. The surrounding cliff faces and scree slopes are up to 1800 million years old and known as King Leopold Sandstone. Erosional forces, such as watercourses, have carved out El Questro Gorge by following a geological fault line. The reward at the end is a crystal-clear waterhole where you can have a refreshing swim before the return walk back to the Homestead in time for lunch. After lunch, enjoy some free time to relax and take in the tranquil surrounds.

This afternoon venture to Buddy's Point lookout, a steep 4WD adventure in El Questro's famous open air safari vehicles. Named after Buddy Tyson, who was the essence of El Questro and an icon of the property, the views from the top take in the heart of the Chamberlain Gorge which cannot be seen in this manner from any other lookout. From this vantage point you can see why El Questro was where Buddy hung his cowboy hat for 20 years.

DAY 8: FRIDAY 7 OCTOBER PURNULULU NATIONAL PARK & ZEBEDEE SPRINGS

Following breakfast at the Homestead, transfer to El Questro Airport for a spectacular Bungle Bungle experience. 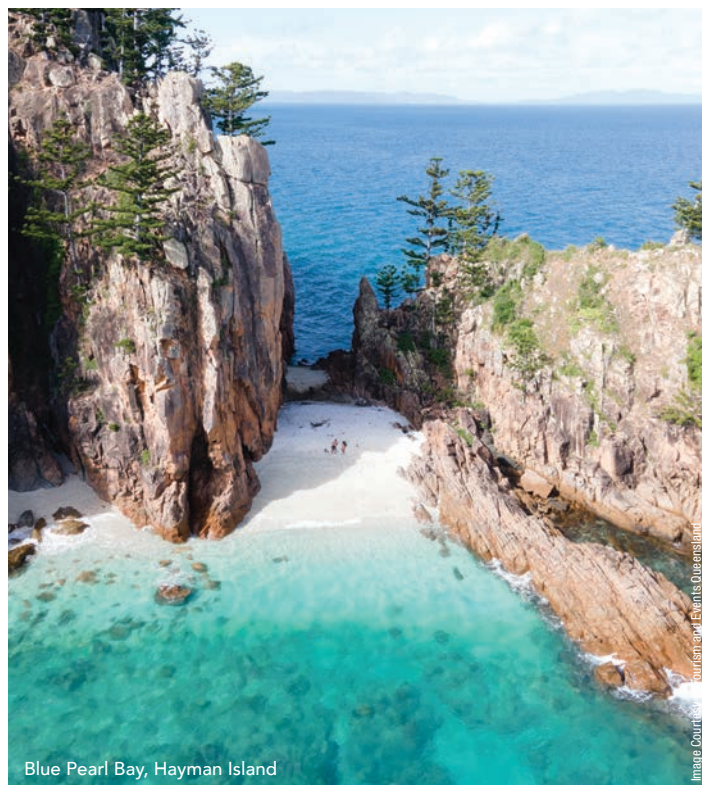
